Cyrille Harnay aka Komakino started downhill racing in 2004, on the IGSA circuit. Shortly after launching his racing career, Cyrille started organizing events under the umbrella of the French Federation at that time (Hautacam Downhill from 2004 to 2006 and Peyragudes Never Dies in 2008, 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014).

After 4 years racing on the tour, Cyrille decided to step down from racing and focus on her involvement in the administrative and event side of the International scene; giving back to the sport that has been an impactful part of her life for so many years.

In 2008 Cyrille became the IGSA European Director. In 2012, and with the sport at a tipping point and looking for a solid future direction Cyrille decided to create the IDF, a nonprofit and democratic association with the help of event organizers, national federation presidents and world champions. As a foundation partner in that early team, Cyrille was nominated IDF President for the first 2 years of the federation.

Cyrille currently serves as the IDF president and works as a consultant for DH disciplines for the French Federation of Roller Reports (Commission Skateboard).
